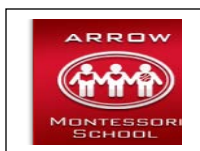

Summer STEM CLASSES (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics)

STEM PROGRAM. Due to the academic and educational benefits of STEM Program this school year, we are extending it through the summer as an extra curricular class. Should you want to continue in the summer , for the K-8th class we are offering it 4 days a week, 1.5hours a day in the afternoon for a reasonable fee of \$89 per week. Last session for the academic year is June 14. This class offers more challenges for children K TO 8TH GRADE. You must be enrolled in our summer camp to be part of the program.

(there must be a minimum of 6 children to open)that will be held at school , from 1:30 to 3 p.m. - every MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY & FRIDAY. You may pick the week or weeks of your choice - fill out the application and send it with payment to the office by JUNE 15. Expect the flyers to be sent home at the beginning of the month. Classes will open each week by meeting the minimum of 6 children per week. We encourage you to enroll your child in these classes as they are essential to your child's academic foundation. Charter Oak Gymnastics. Every Monday from 12:30 - 1 pm. Cost is \$45 for 6 sessions.

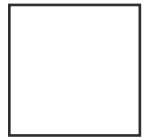
