off to be with their child and offer help with keeping a small group of children with them. Thank you & see you next summer!

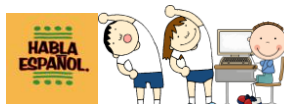


UN DAY & MINI-CARNIVAL / Narconon

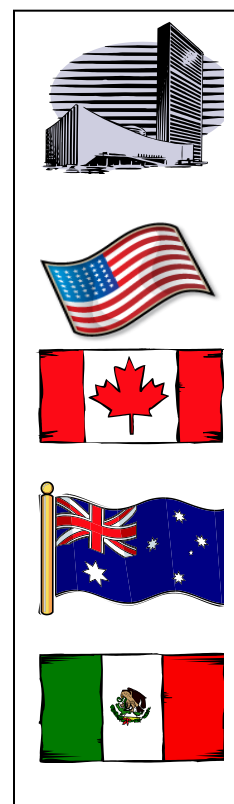

Tuition Fees. Monthly tuition fees are due on the first of each month. Late fees, a total of \$24 applies after the 10th of each month. WE ONLY ACCEPT CHECKS OR CREDIT CARDS (Visa or Mastercard with a 1% processing fee).

Sign In and Out Daily. It is mandatory for all parents/guardians to sign their child in and out daily with their complete first and last names. Children may not sign in behalf of their parents.

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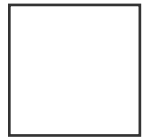
Extra Curricular Activities
